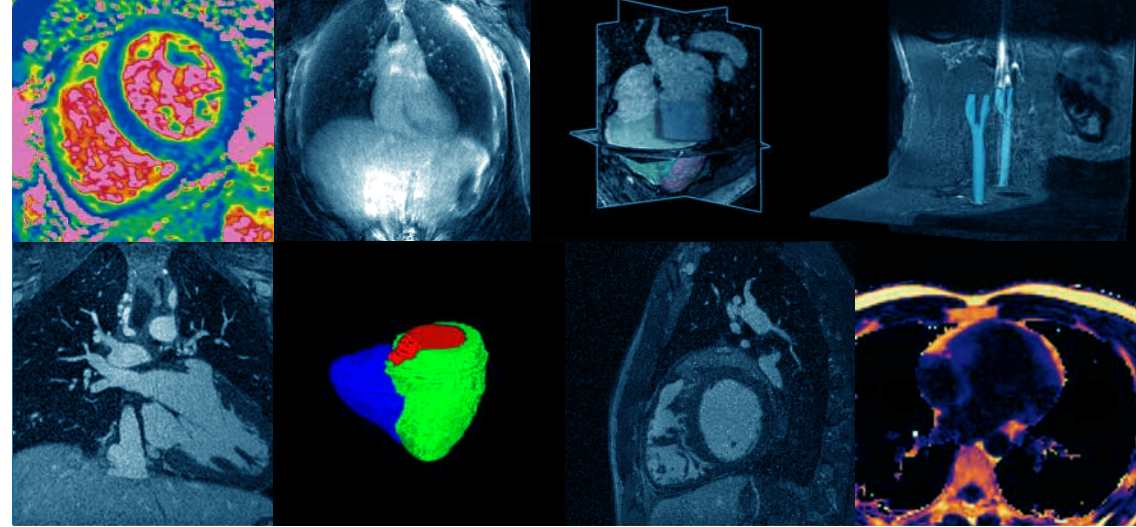


# 10<sup>th</sup> CIBM-CHUV-MR Retreat

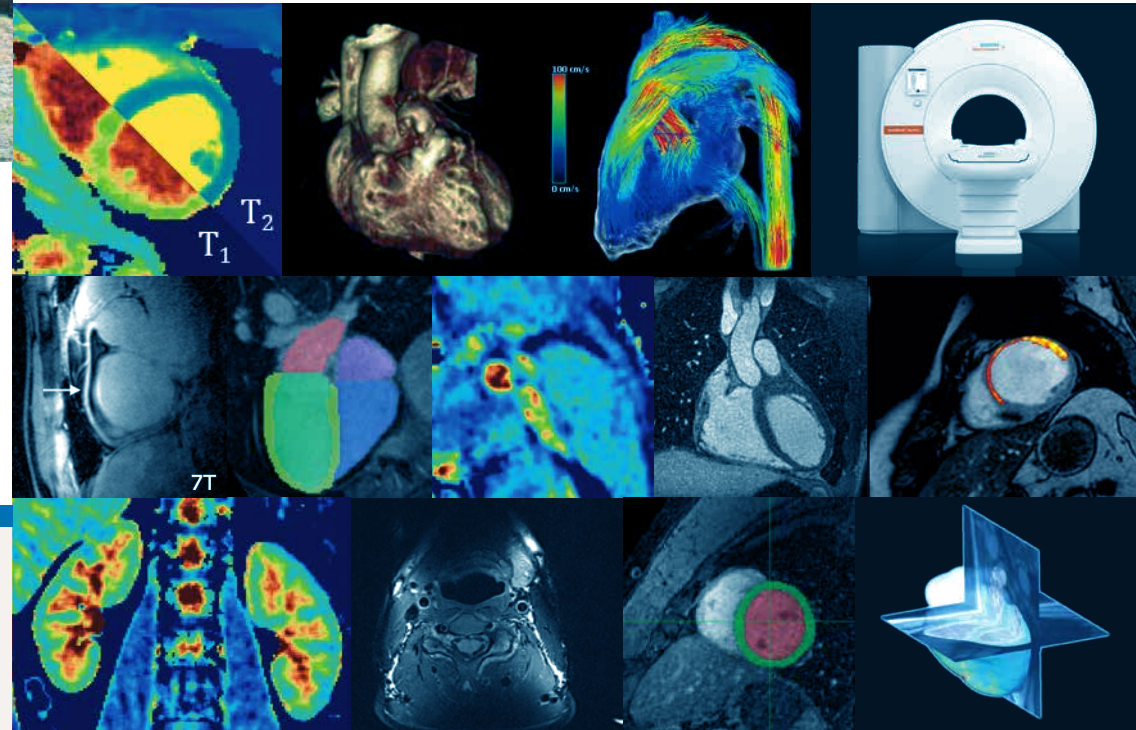
